

MANAGING MINORS IN THE CLUB – GUIDELINES

The following guidelines are approved by the Club Committee of Management to assist in safety and proper supervision of minors attending the Club.

1. No adult should be alone singly inside the club with a minor. When there is only one minor present, the front door must be left open. If the minor is dropped off, try and request the adult dropping the minor off to stay until another person shows up.
2. No minor should be given a lift home without the clear direct approval of the parent or guardian.
3. At the end of any session, if there is only one minor waiting to be picked up, and there is only one adult left, then the minor must wait outside; the adult remains responsible and should keep an eye on the minor until they are picked up.
4. At all times there are minors in the club, there must be a Bridge club individual present that has undergone a police check, except on a regular evening or day session of bridge at the club.
5. Minors must not be allowed into the kitchen/bar area without supervision.
6. Physical contact should be avoided, and cannot be more than a gentle touch on the shoulder to gain attention, or make a point. However, it is suggested no physical contact at all.
7. Any member of the club noting that any of these guidelines is not being followed by an individual should notify John Burville or the President by email as soon as possible.
